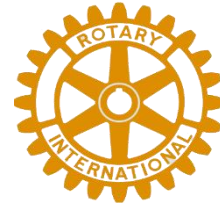

**Glen-Marie Wright**

**Yarran**

Glen-Marie is the CEO of Yarran. Yarran is an aboriginal word for the Acacia Tree. Their mission statement is "supporting your child, your family, your life"  
Yarran can offer the families a choice and mix of support that can change and adapt to the family's needs, transitions through life, access to services and achievements.

It is important to remember the childcare centre, preschool, family day care, school are not Yarran's clients. The parent and child are Yarran's client and therefore Yarran will only take instruction from the parent.

Yarran will:

- Provide emotional, material and informational support to families as well as direct support to their child. This is achieved through routine based interview
- Provide early childhood intervention support and mainstream local community's activities & events for the family's choice

The focus of each program is the provision of play based intervention, implementation and evaluation of an individual support plan for each child

Yarran supports the family to implement strategies with the focus on engagement, independence and social participation.

You can rightly be proud of your support for ShelterBox. As you will read below last year we helped close to 140,000 people. We could not do this without the generosity of supporters like you. In an ever changing world, we increasingly see the need to be flexible in the way we respond to disasters and a 'one size fits all' approach seriously limits the amount of people we can help. Those you who have sponsored boxes will have noticed the increased waiting time for a box to be deployed. That is because we only deploy ShelterBoxes when they are deemed to be the most appropriate form of aid. In 2016 we helped over 29,000 families but only 10% of them received ShelterBoxes.

In certain cases (such as the earthquake in Nepal, cyclone in Vanuatu, and the recent hurricane in Haiti) host governments have not allowed ShelterBoxes to be deployed and asked that we contribute to communities' efforts to self recover. In these cases, shelter kits and other essential items like water filters and solar lights were deployed. This type of aid is funded by the ShelterBox Solution and we would encourage you to support this flexible fund so that we can better serve the needs of the people we help.

Whilst it's important we recognise our achievements, it's also important that re-state our vision of a world where no family goes without shelter following disaster or humanitarian crisis. Right now our Operations team are looking into a forgotten crisis in Chad and the growing needs of hundreds of thousands of families fleeing the fighting in Yemen, only to encounter drought in Somaliland. With your help we can move closer to achieving our goal.
