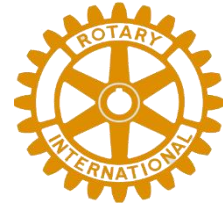

Her heart was pounding now...

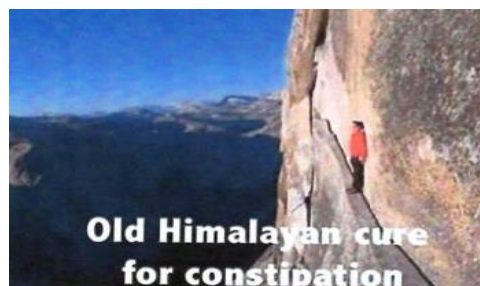
Her face was flushed...
