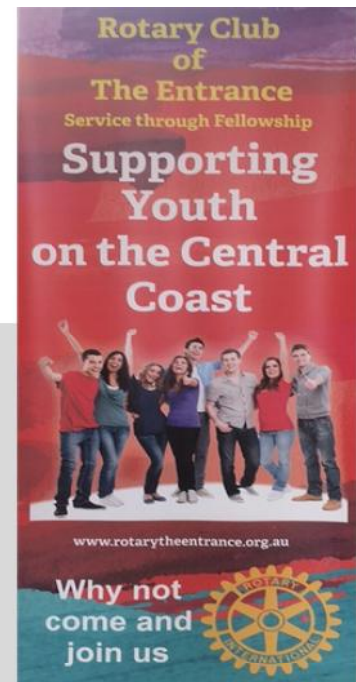

The first meeting of the New Year on Tuesday 2nd July set down as a Club Assembly. This gave all members of the Club , partners of family members & any friends of Rotary the opportunity to join in discussions as to the way the club is run, the Objectives we set for ourselves in the months ahead & how as a Group we intend to achieve them & it was good that Sue Kemp (family member) & Shirl Llewellyn (friend of rotary were able to join us & add their perspective to discussions.

John has done a brief meeting report further in the bulletin but I have focussed below on membership which was the first & most broadly discussed topic & the Community Raffle

1. **Membership** –We talked about having an information night for prospective members & friends & agreed that in fact a breakfast or lunch meeting might have a broader appeal than an evening one. We also agreed that as our club has a wide geographical area that rather than have just one meeting at The Entrance that a second one at Tuggerah close to the Industrial park would make a lot of sense. Gordon agreed to find a suitable venue.

It was recognised that we needed time to think of different ways in which we could contact people who might be interested in Rotary which could include direct approaches to businesses (corporate or individuals) . market stalls or using the network of local organisations that participate in the Community Raffle& that target dates in October should be agreed and set aside. This timing would be after The Community raffle tickets had been distributed (target date meeting on 24th September) .

2. **Community Service & Fundraising activities- this is the essence of a Rotary club.** We need to have an interesting & challenging mixture of activities if we are to retain existing members and attract new ones.
 - Discussions re **The Community Raffle** – It was agreed that the key thing to get moving was to retain past sponsors or get new ones for the Raffle Prizes. Robin agreed to accept responsibility for that & hoped to get them firmed up by mid august so that he could get tickets printed & ready to distribute by the new planned date of 24th September (previously 17th)
 - **Bunnings BBQs** – rostering for wed 31st July (5th Wed) & 3rd Wednesdays from August initially to October. Proposal to take on 3 additional 5th Wednesdays as extras in conjunction with other community organisations was agreed by all present. Yarran, Ronald McDonald Room & Wyong Inner Wheel have all shown an interest.
 - **New major project for the club**, depending on the size & scope we could seek to partner with another club or organisation
3. **The Programme-** David Waterhouse, in his role as Club Service Director has produced the framework of a programme for the 12 months which we discussed and made some changes in the first 4 months. Broadly speaking after July he has penciled in 2 dinner meetings a month – the 1st Tuesday is designated for a quality outside speaker. The 3rd Tuesday is down as a Rotary speaker & he has suggested a roster of club members. This as meaning that that member has to be the speaker for that meeting those nominated could provide a friend or contact to speak on a topic of interest. It's only once a year for most of us! Both of these meetings need to be attractive not only to our members but to prospective members & visitors we wish to bring along.

Club Speakers

1. On the third Tuesday of each Month, a member of the club will be rostered on to be the speaker for the night.
2. The choice of topic will be at the discretion of the member.
3. The talk shall be for 25 mins with 5 mins for questions.
4. The topic shall be forwarded to the admin director approx 6 weeks prior for inclusion into the Bulletin.
5. If a member is unable to give a talk on the scheduled date they are to negotiate a swap with another member.
6. Any changes shall be forwarded to the admin Director for inclusion in the Bulletin'
